A RESOLUTION

TO RECOGNIZE THE MEN AND WOMEN OF LAW-ENFORCEMENT IN THE BATON ROUGE AREA AND LSU FOR THEIR TIRELESS SERVICE TO KEEPING THE CAMPUS COMMUNITY SAFE AND TO HONOR THOSE WHO HAVE LOST THEIR LIVES IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, EVERY DAY POLICE OFFICERS IN THE AREA PUT THEIR LIVES ON THE LINE TO MAINTAIN THE SAFETY OF LSU AND THE BATON ROUGE AREA; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, EAST BATON ROUGE SHERIFF'S DEPUTY, SGT. SHAWN T. ANDERSON, WAS KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY ON MARCH 18, 2017, WHILE SELFLESSLY SERVING THE BATON ROUGE AREA; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE LOUISIANA STATE POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE BATON ROUGE POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE EAST BATON ROUGE SHERIFF'S OFFICE DESERVE PROPER RECOGNITION FOR THEIR DEDICATION TO KEEPING LSU'S CAMPUS AND THE AREAS AROUND IT AS SAFE AS POSSIBLE.

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT THE MEN AND WOMEN OF LAW-ENFORCEMENT IN THE BATON ROUGE AREA ARE RECOGNIZED FOR THEIR TIRELESS SERVICE TO KEEPING THE CAMPUS COMMUNITY SAFE AND THOSE WHO HAVE LOST THEIR LIVES IN THE LINE OF DUTY ARE HONORED FOR THEIR DEDICATION TO THE SAFETY OF THE COMMUNITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 5: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO LAWRENCE RABALAIS, CHIEF OF THE LSU POLICE DEPARTMENT; MAJOR KEVIN REEVES, INTERIM SUPERINTENDENT OF LOUISIANA STATE POLICE; CHIEF CARL DABADIE, BATON ROUGE POLICE DEPARTMENT; SID J. GAUTREAUX III, SHERRIFF OF THE EAST BATON ROUGE SHERIFF'S OFFICE.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (ONE-HALF PLUS ONE) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL
