FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 78-5

WHEREAS, the LSU Board of Supervisors is considering relocating the Law Center to a site remote from the LSU campus and

WHEREAS, no apparent advantage will accrue to the diverse educational mission of the LSU system from the proposed move while the disadvantages are numerous and significant,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the LSU faculty make known its unalterable opposition to this unwarranted act of further fragmentation of the University.
