9 **A FINANCE BILL**

10 **TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF SIX-THOUSAND ONE-HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS**  
11 **AND EIGHTY-FOUR CENTS (6,136.84) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES**  
12 **ACCOUNT TO FUND THE ACQUISITION OF TWO DIFFERENT TYPES OF 'SCANTRONS' AND**  
13 **ONE STYLE OF 'BLUEBOOK' FOR THE STUDENT BODY TO USE DURING THE UPCOMING**  
14 **FALL AND SPRING FINAL EXAMINATION PERIODS**

16 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE ISSUANCE OF 'SCANTRONS' AND 'BLUE BOOKS'  
17 THROUGH THE STUDENT SENATE WOULD ALLOW FOR EASIER  
18 ACCESS TO TESTING MATERIALS FOR THE UPCOMING FINAL  
19 EXAMINATION PERIODS AND;

21 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE DEMAND FOR THESE TESTING MATERIALS HAS  
22 CONTINUED TO BE VOICE BY THE STUDENT BODY AS A DIRECT USE  
23 OF STUDENT FEES AND;

25 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, A PORTION OF THESE TESTING MATERIALS WILL BE  
26 RESERVED FOR THE UPCOMING SPRING FINAL EXAMINATION  
27 PERIOD IN ORDER TO ASSURE AN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO  
28 STUDENTS DURING THE SPRING FINAL EXAMINATION PERIOD AS  
29 WOULD BE AVAILABLE IN THE FALL AND;

31 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE UNIVERSITY WILL BE  
32 ASSURED AN OPPORTUNITY TO OBTAIN THESE TESTING  
33 MATERIALS FROM THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OFFICE AT NO  
34 CHARGE WHILE SUPPLIES LASTS AND;

36 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, AN EFFICIENT STRATEGY FOR FAIR DISTRIBUTION OF  
37 THESE TESTING MATERIALS WILL BE DEVELOPED PRIOR TO THE  
38 FALL FINAL EXAMINATION PERIOD AND;

40 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, FUNDING THESE TESTING MATERIALS FOR THE  
41 STUDENT BODY WOULD SERVE AS A WORTHY ALLOCATION OF  
42 STUDENT FEES THAT WOULD DIRECTLY BENEFIT ALL STUDENTS  
43 THAT RESPONSE TO THIS AMENITY AND;

45 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, THE AMOUNT OF SIX-THOUSAND ONE-HUNDRED  
46 THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS AND EIGHTY FOUR CENTS (\$6136.84) WILL  
47 BE ALLOCATED TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF THE FOLLOWING  
48 TYPES OF SCANTRONS:

51 b. 5,000 SMALL 'SCANTRONS' @ \$270.00  
52 c. 7,200 'BLUE BOOKS' @ \$5,400.00

**PARAGRAPH 9:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE TRANSMITTED TO Mrs. ALISA JONES, THE FINANCIAL COORDINATOR FOR THE LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT.

**PARAGRAPH 10:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
