A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$1,218.00) FROM THE LEGISLATIVE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND SOGAND KARBALAIEALI'S TRAVEL TO THE TRANSPORTATION RESEARCH BOARD ANNUAL MEETING ON JANUARY 7TH-11TH, 2018.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE TRANSPORTATION RESEARCH BOARD (TRB) 97TH ANNUAL MEETING WILL BE HELD JANUARY 7TH-11TH, 2018 AT THE WALTER E. WASHINGTON CONVENTION CENTER, IN WASHINGTON D.C.; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE INFORMATION PACKED PROGRAM IS EXPECTED TO ATTRACT MORE THAN 13,000 TRANSPORTATION PROFESSIONALS FROM AROUND THE WORLD, WITH THE ABILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN OVER 800 DIFFERENT WORKSHOPS AND INFORMATION SESSIONS TO DEVELOP THEIR OWN CAREER PATH; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THIS EXPENDITURE WOULD COVER THE FOLLOWING ACQUISITIONS:

1. **REGISTRATION: \$195.00**
 2. **HOTEL: \$635.00**
 3. **FLIGHT AND BAGGAGE: \$348.00**
 4. **TAXI TO AND FROM AIRPORT: \$40.00**
- TOTAL = \$1,218.00.**

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT A MAXIMUM OF ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$1,218.00) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE LEGISLATIVE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE TRAVEL AND REGISTRATION FEES FOR SOGAND KARBALAIEALI, AND

PARAGRAPH 5: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL BE TRANSMITTED TO CORTNEY GREAVIS, STUDENT GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL COORDINATOR.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS ($2/3$) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
