10 **TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO**  
11 **CENTS (\$2,500.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT AND A**  
12 **MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$2,500.00)**  
13 **FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT SENATE GENERAL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO**  
14 **FUND THE STUDENT LIFE AND ENROLLMENT HAZING EDUCATION AND PREVENTION**  
15 **PROACTIVE INITIATIVES**

17 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THIS IS A NEW CAMPAIGN STARTED BY THE OFFICE OF  
18 STUDENT LIFE AND ENROLLMENT TO EDUCATE THE UNIVERSITY  
19 ON ISSUES OF HAZING ACROSS CAMPUS; AND

20  
21 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, STUDENT SENATE HAS PASSED A RESOLUTION TO  
22 SUPPORT THIS ANTI HAZING CAMPAIGN; AND

23  
24 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, DUE TO RECENT INCIDENTS OCCURRING ON OUR  
25 CAMPUS AND CAMPUSES ACROSS THE NATION IN REGARDS TO  
26 HAZING, THIS CAMPAIGN WILL EXPEDITE THE PROCESS OF  
27 HAZING EDUCATION AND PREVENTION; AND

29 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE REQUESTED FUNDS WILL GO TO PAY FOR THE  
30 CREATION OF A PROFESSIONAL PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT  
31 TO EVERYONE, ESPECIALLY STUDENTS, ON CAMPUS; AND

33 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE MONEY WOULD BE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

35 1. VIDEO PRODUCTION - \$4,000  
36 2. ADVERTISEMENTS - \$1,000  
37 **TOTAL - \$5,000**

39 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA  
40 STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT A MAXIMUM  
41 OF TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS  
42 (\$2,500.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES  
43 ACCOUNT AND A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED  
44 DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$2,500.00) FROM THE STUDENT  
45 GOVERNMENT SENATE GENERAL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT BE  
46 ALLOCATED TO FUND THE STUDENT LIFE AND ENROLLMENT  
47 HAZING EDUCATION AND PREVENTION PROACTIVE INITIATIVES.

49 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS  
50 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY  
51 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL  
52 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY  
53 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
