8 TO AMEND ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY
9 STUDENT GOVERNMENT TO INCLUDE AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE.

10 PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE PURPOSE OF LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT IS TO
11 PROVIDE SERVICE TO ALL STUDENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY; AND

12 PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY PRACTICES A
13 POLICY THAT PROVIDES EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO ALL STUDENTS;
14 AND

15 PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT, STRONGLY SUPPORTS
16 AND PRACTICES THE PRINCIPLES OF EQUALITY, CIVILITY, AND
17 RESPECT; AND

18 PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT WANTS TO REAFFIRM
19 THESE PRINCIPLES THAT ARE ALREADY IN PRACTICE BY
20 AMENDING ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION AS FOLLOWS:

21 SECTION 4. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

22 IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LSU STUDENT
23 GOVERNMENT TO SERVE ALL LSU STUDENTS WITHOUT
24 REGARD TO RACE, CREED, COLOR, MARITAL STATUS, SEXUAL
25 ORIENTATION, GENDER IDENTITY, GENDER EXPRESSION,
26 RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, MENTAL OR PHYSICAL
27 DISABILITY, OR VETERAN'S STATUS

28 SECTION 4-5. GOVERNING STRUCTURE

29 PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
30 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
31 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT
32 ARTICLE I OF THE LSU STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONSTITUTION
33 BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE AN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE.

34 PARAGRAPH 6: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS
35 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO K.C. WHITE, DEAN OF
36 STUDENTS; AND CHAUNDA M. ALLEN, DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE
37 OF MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS.

38 PARAGRAPH 7: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
39 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY
40 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
41 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
42 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
