A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$850.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND RAYMOND DOE'S, A MASTERS STUDENT AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY (LSU), TRAVEL TO PRESENT AT THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON URBAN EDUCATION IN MONTEGO BAY, JAMAICA.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, RAYMOND DOE IS A FULL TIME GRADUATE STUDENT AND HAS ALREADY APPLIED FOR GRADUTE TRAVEL GRANT AND RECEIVED WHAT IS SHOWN BELOW AND REQUESTS MORE FUNDING TO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE, AS HE HAS NO OTHER SOURCE OF FUNDING; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, HE WILL PRESENTING HIS TWO PAPERS: THE FIRST STUDY EXAMINES THE INFLUENCE OF SELECTED PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS ON THE CRITICAL THINKING ABILITIES OF HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS AND THE SECOND EXAMINES THE PERCEPTIONS OF ACADEMIC ADMINISTRATORS, TENURED FACULTY, AND TENURE-TRACK FACULTY AT RU/VH: RESEARCH UNIVERSITIES (VERY HIGH RESEARCH ACTIVITY) IN THE SOUTHEASTERN REGION OF THE UNITED STATES REGARDING STOPPING THE TENURE CLOCK; AND
