A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-ONE DOLLARS AND THIRTY SEVEN CENTS (\$2,351.37) FROM THE LEGISLATIVE GENERAL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE STUDENTS OF THE COLLEGE OF ART & DESIGN IN AN INITIATIVE TO DESIGN AND BUILD A DIRECTORY WITH SEATING INSTALLATION IN THE DESIGN BUILDING ATRIUM

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, REBUILDING THE EXISTING DIMINISHING DIRECTORY WILL BETTER COMMUNICATE TO STUDENTS AND VISITORS NAVIGATING THE BUILDING WHILE INCLUDING ADDITIONAL BENCH SEATING IN THE FIRST FLOOR FOR STUDENTS WAITING TO GET INTO THEIR CLASSES; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE STUDENT WORK WILL POSITIVELY REFLECT THE STUDENT TALENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF ART & DESIGN WITH BEAUTIFICATION OF THE CAMPUS; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE STUDENT-LED INITIATIVE PROMOTES THE IMPROVEMENT OF CAMPUS INFRASTRUCTURE THROUGH DESIGNS CREATED BY STUDENTS; AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE CONTINUED SUPPORT FOR THIS INITIATIVE PROMOTES INTERDISCIPLINARY INVOLVEMENT AND GIVES STUDENTS WITHIN THE CORRESPONDING AREAS HANDS-ON OPPORTUNITIES; AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, STUDENT GOVERNMENT IS SUPPORTIVE OF THE INITIATIVE AND ITS PLANS FOR THE PROGRAM EXPANDING INTO OTHER AREAS OF CAMPUS IN THE FUTURE; AND

PARAGRAPH 6: WHEREAS, THE BUDGET IS LISTED BELOW;

PARAGRAPH 7: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT A MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-ONE DOLLARS AND THIRTY SEVEN CENTS (\$2,351.37) FROM THE LEGISLATIVE GENERAL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE STUDENTS OF THE COLLEGE OF ART & DESIGN IN AN INITIATIVE TO DESIGN AND BUILD A DIRECTORY WITH SEATING INSTALLATION IN THE DESIGN BUILDING ATRIUM.

PARAGRAPH 8: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
