A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST LSU FACILITY SERVICES TO PROVIDE MORE ELECTRICAL OUTLETS THROUGHOUT CAMPUS.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE LSU FACULTY CONTINUES TO INNOVATE AND GROW WITH SOCIETY IN THE USE OF ELECTRONIC CURRICULUM AND ACTIVITIES, AND;

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, LSU STUDENTS TAKE FULL ADVANTAGE OF MODERN TECHNOLOGY IN THEIR STUDIES AND DAILY LIVES, AND;

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, RESEARCH FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO CLAIMS THAT 70 PERCENT OF COLLEGE STUDENTS USE A COMPUTER FOR SCHOOLWORK DAILY, AND;

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, MANY LSU CLASSROOMS, AUDITORIUMS, AND STUDY AREAS ARE NOT ADEQUATELY EQUIPPED WITH ELECTRICAL OUTLETS, AND ;

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, LSU FACILITY SERVICES' MISSION STATEMENTS SAYS "TO SUPPORT THE UNIVERSITY'S VISION, MISSION, AND GOALS, BY PROVIDING ALL CAMPUS ENTITIES WITH QUALITY FACILITIES..."


PARAGRAPH 6: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT LSU FACILITY SERVICES PROVIDE MORE ELECTRICAL OUTLETS THROUGHOUT CAMPUS.

PARAGRAPH 7: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO ROGER HUSSER, DIRECTOR OF PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION FOR LSU FACILITY SERVICES.

PARAGRAPH 8: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
