10 TO URGE AND REQUEST THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY'S (LSU) EMERGENCY
11 OPERATIONS CENTER (EOC) TO INCLUDE THE STUDENTS IN THE LSU CONTINUING
12 EDUCATION PROGRAM IN THE EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

14 PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, ALL STUDENTS SHOULD HAVE THE OPTION TO RECEIVE
15 TEXT OR EMAIL NOTIFICATIONS IN EMERGENCY SITUATIONS,
16 AND;

18 PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, TIMELY NOTIFICATION FROM POLICE TO THE
19 STUDENTS IS VITAL IN KEEPING OUR CAMPUS SAFE, AND;

21 PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE STUDENTS IN THE CONTINUING EDUCATION
22 PROGRAM ARE CONSIDERED TO BE STUDENTS AND PAY TUITION
23 TO THIS UNIVERSITY, AND;

25 PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THESE STUDENTS SHOULD BE NOTIFIED IF ANYTHING
26 DANGEROUS WERE TO HAPPEN ON OR AROUND CAMPUS, AND;

28 PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, THESE STUDENTS ALREADY HAVE ACCESS TO MYLSU
29 AND SHOULD ALSO BE GRANTED ACCESS TO THIS SERVICE, AND;

31 PARAGRAPH 6: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
32 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
33 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THE
34 LSU EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER BE URGED TO INCLUDE
35 THE STUDENTS IN THE LSU CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM
36 IN THE EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM, AND;

38 PARAGRAPH 7: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS
39 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO D'ANN MORRIS,
40 DIRECTOR OF THE EOC, AND CHIEF LARRY RABALAIS, CHIEF OF
41 POLICE OF THE LSU PD.

43 PARAGRAPH 8: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A
44 SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE
45 AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR
46 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND
47 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF
48 SUCH APPROVAL.
