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14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, UPON STUDENT-LED INSPECTION OF LSU DINING
15 HALLS, THE 5 AND THE 459, VISIBLY PROVIDE INFORMATION ON
16 ALL ALLERGENS THAT BE PRESENT IN OR HAVE COME IN WITH,
17 INCLUDING BUT LIMITED TO THE PRESENCE OR CONTACT OF
18 DAIRY, PEANUTS, TREE NUTS, EGG, WHEAT, SOY, FISH, GLUTEN,
19 OR SHELLFISH, IN THE FOOD SERVED; AND,

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21 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE ONLY INFORMATION ABOUT ALLERGEN IN FOOD
22 SERVED IN DINING HALL LOCATIONS WAS FOUND ON THE LSU
23 DINING APP; AND,

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25 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THIS INFORMATION WAS FOUND TO BE INCONSISTENT
26 AND AT TIMES INCORRECT ABOUT THE FOOD BEING PROVIDED;

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29 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, NOT ALL STUDENTS HAVE ACCESS TO SMART PHONES
30 CAPABLE OF ACCESSING THE NECESSARY DINING APP; AND,

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32 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, ANYONE WHO HAS A FOOD ALLERGY CAN EXPERIENCE
33 ANAPHYLAXIS, A SEVERE ALLERGIC REACTION THAT IS RAPID IN
34 ONSET THAT MAY ULTIMATELY LEAD TO DEATH; AND,

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36 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, ACCORDING TO THE FOOD ALLERGY AND
37 ANAPHYLAXIS MANAGEMENT ACT, SIGNED INTO LAW ON
38 JANUARY 4, 2011, BY PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA, REQUIRES ALL
39 SCHOOLS, INCLUDING HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS, TO
40 ADOPT A POLICY TO MANAGE THE RISK OF FOOD ALLERGY AND
41 ANAPHYLAXIS IN SCHOOLS; AND,

49 OR SHELLFISH WHICH MAY BE PRESENT IN OR HAVE COME IN
50 CONTACT WITH FOOD PROVIDED AT LSU ON-CAMPUS DINING
51 LOCATIONS AND LSU DINING CATERED EVENTS.

DIRECTOR OF THE 459 COMMONS.


PARAGRAPH 9:
