9 **A RESOLUTION**

10 **TO URGE AND REQUEST THE OFFICE OF PARKING & TRANSPORTATION SERVICES TO**
11 **LIFT STUDENT PARKING ZONES DURING SPRING INTERSESSION, SUMMER TERM, AND**
12 **SUMMER INTERSESSION**

14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, DURING THESE TERMS THE STUDENT POPULATION IS
15 VASTLY REDUCED AND PARKING IS MORE AVAILABLE; AND

17 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, COMMUTER STUDENTS TAKING COURSES DURING THE
18 STATED TERMS ARE LIMITED TO PARKING IN THEIR RESPECTIVE
19 LOTS, WHEN THERE ARE VACANCIES THROUGHOUT RESIDENTIAL
20 LOTS, AND GREEK LOTS; AND

22 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS LIFTING ZONE RESTRICTIONS DURING THESE TERMS
23 WOULD ALLOW STUDENTS AN EASIER COMMUTE AND A BETTER
24 USAGE OF AVAILABLE PARKING ON CAMPUS.

26 **PARAGRAPH 4:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
27 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
28 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THE
29 STUDENT BODY URGES THE PARKING & TRANSPORTATION
30 SERVICE TO LIFT PARKING ZONES DURING SPRING INTERSESSION,
31 SUMMER SCHOOL, AND SUMMER INTERSESSION.

33 **PARAGRAPH 5:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS
34 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO THE OFFICE OF
35 PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION.

37 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A
38 SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE
39 AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR
40 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND
41 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF
42 SUCH APPROVAL.
