11 **TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO**
12 **CENTS (\$1,700.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT SENATE CONTINGENCY**
13 **ACCOUNT TO FUND THE SCIENCE COLLEGE COUNCIL'S FIRST ANNUAL BUS TRIP TO**
14 **LSU NEW ORLEANS SCHOOL OF MEDICINE.**

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16 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE SCIENCE COLLEGE COUNCIL, AN ENTITY OF
17 STUDENT GOVERNMENT, IMPLEMENTS SEVERAL PROGRAMMING
18 EVENTS FOR STUDENTS EACH YEAR, AND;

20 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE SCIENCE COLLEGE COUNCIL IS INITIATING ITS
21 FIRST ANNUAL BUS TRIP TO LSU NEW ORLEANS SCHOOL OF
22 MEDICINE, AND;

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24 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THIS BUS TRIP IS CENTERED AROUND THE SCHOOL OF
25 MEDICINE'S OPEN HOUSE EVENT ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2013,

29 CONFIRMING THEIR CAREER ASPIRATIONS IN MEDICINE AS IT

64 (\$1,610.00) PRICED FOR TWO (2) BUSES FOR SEVEN (7) HOURS

68 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
69 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE ALLOCATES A
70 MAXIMUM OF ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS AND
71 ZERO CENTS (\$1,700.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
72 SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND TRANSPORTATION
73 FOR THE SCIENCE COLLEGE COUNCIL'S FIRST ANNUAL BUS TRIP

76 **PARAGRAPH 13:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
77 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY
78 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
79 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
80 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
