11 **FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE**  
12 **PERCUSSION SOCIETY AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY TO ATTEND THE PERCUSSIVE**  
13 **ARTS SOCIETY INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION (PASIC) IN INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA**  
14 **FROM NOVEMBER 13<sup>TH</sup>-17<sup>TH</sup> AS REPRESENTATIVES OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY**  
15 **AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE (LSU)**

17 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE PERCUSSION SOCIETY AT LSU IS COMPROMISED  
18 OF FIFTEEN (15) UNDERGRADUATE AND FOUR (4) GRADUATE  
19 STUDENTS, AND;

21 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, TWELVE OF THE NINETEEN MEMBERS WILL BE  
22 ATTENDING THE CONFERENCE, AND;

24 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, LSU HAS NOT BEEN REPRESENTED AT THE PASIC  
25 CONFERENCE IN OVER SIX (6) YEARS, AND;

26  
27 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE PASIC CONFERENCE IS THE LARGEST MUSIC  
28 CONFERENCE HELD IN AMERICA WITH ROUGHLY SIX THOUSAND  
29 (6,000) IN ATTENDANCE, AND;

30  
31 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE PERCUSSION SOCIETY IS HOSTING THE LOUISIANA  
32 DAY OF PERCUSSION DURING THE SPRING 2014 SEMESTER, AND;

33  
34 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, ATTENDING THE PASIC CONFERENCE WOULD BETTER  
35 PREPARE THE ORGANIZATION TO HOST THE LOUISIANA DAY OF  
36 PERCUSSION, AND;

38 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, THE ORGANIZATION HAS FUNDRAISED FOUR HUNDRED  
39 AND SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$475), AND;

41 **PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THE ORGANIZATION HAS PAID FOR THEIR OWN  
42 REGISTRATION AT ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE DOLLARS  
43 (\$165) PER PERSON, AND;

45 **PARAGRAPH 9:** WHEREAS, THE FUNDS WOULD COVER GAS FOR FOUR VEHICLES  
46 TRAVELING ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY (1,950) MILES,

49 **PARAGRAPH 10:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA  
50 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND  
51 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT A  
52 MAXIMUM OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS  
53 (\$1,000.00) BE ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
