## A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF ONE-THOUSAND FOUR-HUNDRED AND ZERO CENTS (\$1,400.00) FROM THE SENATE CONTINGENCY TO THE LSU CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL STUDENT SPEECH LANGUAGE HEARING ASSOCIATION (NSSLHA) FOR FLIGHTS TO ATTEND THE AMERICAN SPEECH-LEARNING-HEARING ASSOCIATION (ASHA) 2013 CONVENTION IN CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE NATIONAL STUDENT SPEECH LANGUAGE HEARING ASSOCIATION WAS FOUNDED IN 1972 AS A PRE-PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR GRADUATE AND UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS INTERESTED IN THE STUDY OF COMMUNICATION SCIENCE AND DISORDERS, AND;

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, NSSLHA IS THE ONLY OFFICIAL NATIONAL STUDENT ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED BY THE AMERICAN SPEECH-LEARNING-HEARING ASSOCIATION (ASHA), AND;

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, NSSLHA HAS ABOUT 13,000 MEMBERS AND MORE THAN 300 LOCAL CHAPTERS IN COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES LOCATED INTERNATIONALLY, AND;

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE AMERICAN SPEECH-LEARNING-HEARING ASSOCIATION (ASHA) IS THE NATIONAL PROFESSIONAL, SCIENTIFIC AND CREDENTIALING ORGANIZATION FOR PROFESSIONALS IN COMMUNICATION SCIENCES AND DISORDERS, REPRESENTING AUDIOLOGISTS, SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS, MEMBERS, INTERNATIONAL AFFILIATES AND SPEECH, LANGUAGE AND HEARING SCIENTISTS – MORE THAN 145, 481 PROFESSIONALS IN ALL, AND;

**PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE LSU CHAPTER OF NSSLHA HAS REMAINED IN ACTIVE STATUS ON THIS CAMPUS FOR OVER THIRTY-FIVE YEARS, AND;

**PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE SEVEN OF THE NINE EXECUTIVE OFFICERS ATTENDING THIS CONFERENCE FROM NOVEMBER 14<sup>TH</sup>, 2013 TO NOVEMBER 16<sup>TH</sup> WILL BE ACTING AS REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE ENTIRE LSU COMMUNICATION DISORDERS COMMUNITY, AND;

**PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, ATTENDING THIS CONVENTION IN CHICAGO, IL WILL PROVIDE FOR THE SEVEN OFFICERS A PLETHORA OF KNOWLEDGE AND RESOURCES CONCERNING FIELD WORK, RESEARCH METHODS, GRADUATE STUDIES AND CAREER OPPORTUNITIES THAT WILL THEN BE SHARED WITH ALL MEMBERS OF THE LSU CHAPTER OF NSSLHA AND OTHER STUDENTS OF THE DEPARTMENT, AND;

55 **PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THE SEVEN ATTENDING MEMBERS OF THE LSU  
56 NSSLHA CHAPTER REQUEST THE SUM OF \$1,400.00 TO PAY FOR  
57 HALF THE ESTIMATED COST OF AIR TRAVEL FROM NEW ORLEANS,  
58 LOUISIANA TO CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, AND;

60 **PARAGRAPH 9:** WHEREAS, THE ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF ROUNDTrip AIRFARE  
61 FOR SEVEN PERSONS AS OF TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2013 IS  
62 APPROXIMATELY \$3,100.00 FROM NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA TO  
63 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, AND;

65 **PARAGRAPH 10:** WHEREAS, THE PRICE WOULD BE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS:  
66 7 PERSONS ATTENDING  
67 \$200 PER PERSON TO PAY FOR HALF OF THE ESTIMATE AIRFARE  
68  $7 \times \$200.00 = \$1,400.00$

70 **PARAGRAPH 11:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA  
71 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND  
72 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT A  
73 MAXIMUM OF ONE-THOUSAND FOUR-HUNDRED AND ZERO  
74 CENTS (\$1,400.00) BE ALLOCATED TO THE LSU CHAPTER  
75 OF THE NATION STUDENT SPEECH LANGUAGE  
76 HEARING ASSOCIATION (NSSLHA) TO ATTEND THE  
77 AMERICAN SPEECH-LEARNING-HEARING  
78 ASSOCIATION (ASHA) 2013 CONVENTION IN CHICAGO,

81 **PARAGRAPH 12:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS  
82 ( $2/3$ ) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY  
83 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL  
84 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY  
85 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
