9 **A FINANCE BILL**

10 **TO ALLOCATE TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$2,500.00)**
11 **FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO FUND THREE (3)**
12 **WATER BOTTLE REFILLING STATIONS IN THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY**
13 **AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE (LSU) STUDENT UNION.**

15 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THESE WATER BOTTLE REFILLING STATIONS PROVIDE
16 A CHEAPER ALTERNATIVE TO PURCHASING VENDING MACHINE
17 BEVERAGES, AND;

19 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, WATER BOTTLE REFILLING STATIONS ARE A
20 HEALTHIER ALTERNATIVE FOR LSU STUDENTS, AND;

22 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, WATER BOTTLE REFILLING STATIONS ARE A MORE
23 SUSTAINABLE OPTION FOR THE UNIVERSITY AND WILL DIMINISH
24 THE AMOUNT OF PLASTIC WASTE, AND;

26 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS IDENTICAL REFILLING STATIONS ARE USED IN
27 UNIVERSITY RECREATION CENTER, AND;

29 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, EACH STATION WILL COST FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS
30 (\$500.00), PLUS ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) FOR
31 INSTALLATION AS WELL AS ANY UNFORESEEN COSTS.

33 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA
34 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
35 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT A
36 MAXIMUM OF TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND
37 ZERO CENTS (\$2,500.00) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
38 INITIATIVES ACCOUNT WILL BE ALLOCATED TO FUND THREE
39 WATER BOTTLE REFILLING STATIONS IN THE STUDENT UNION,

42 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
43 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY
44 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
45 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
46 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
