11 **TO ESTABLISH A LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND**  
12 **MECHANICAL COLLEGE (LSU) CODE OF HONOR AND HONOR BOARD**

14 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, LSU IS THE FLAGSHIP INSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF  
15 LOUISIANA AND;

17 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, LISTED WITHIN THE LSU FLAGSHIP 2020 STRATEGIC  
18 PLAN IS IMPROVING THE STATE OF THE UNIVERSITY BY  
19 CHALLENGING UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE STUDENTS TO  
20 ACHIEVE THE HIGHEST LEVELS OF INTELLECTUAL AND PERSONAL  
21 DEVELOPMENT, AND;

23 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, ELEVEN OUT OF THE THIRTEEN PEER INSTITUTIONS  
24 HAVE IN PLACE A CODE OF HONOR DESCRIBING A COLLECTIVE  
25 PHILOSOPHY AGREED UPON BY THE UNIVERISTY COMMUNITY  
26 REGARDING ACADEMIC INTEGRITY, AND;

27  
28 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, OF THE MEMBER SCHOOLS OF THE AMERICAN  
29 ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITIES, AN ORGANIZATION LSU STRIVES  
30 TO BE IMMOLATE, FIVE HAVE AN HONOR CODE IN PLACE, AND;

31  
32 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, SECTION 8 OF THE LSU CODE OF STUDENT  
33 CONDUCT SHALL NEED TO BE REVISED TO INCORPORATE SAID  
34 CODE OF HONOR DISPLAYING THOSE PRINCIPLES THAT THE  
35 STUDENTS COLLECTIVELY FEEL SHOULD BE CONSIDERED A  
36 VIOLATION OF A UNIFORMLY ACCEPTED CODE OF HONOR, AND;

38 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, A CODE OF HONOR SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE  
39 EFFORTS TO COMBAT CHEATING, FABRICATION, FACILITATING  
40 ACADEMIC DISHONESTY, AND PLAGIARISM, AND;

42 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, SUCH A CODE OF HONOR SHALL CONSIST OF AN HONOR  
43 STATEMENT BEING A SHORT CLAUSE TO BE WRITTEN ON SYLLABI,  
44 TESTS, PAPERS TO BE SUBMITTED, ETC... AND A LONG VERSION  
45 OUTLINING AN HONOR PHILOSOPHY TO BE COLLECTIVELY AGREED  
46 UPON BY THE LSU COMMUNITY, AND;

48 **PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, AN HONOR BOARD SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE  
49 OFFICE OF THE DEAN OF STUDENTS CONSISTING OF 14  
50 STUDENTS, REPRESENTING EACH RESPECTIVE COLLEGE, TO SERVE  
51 AS A JURY OF PEERS TO HEAR CASES, FIRST AND FOREMOST, WHEN  
52 STUDENTS ARE CHARGED WITH VIOLATING THE LSU CODE OF  
53 HONOR AND;

55 **PARAGRAPH 9:** WHEREAS, IT IS IN THE HOPE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE  
56 THAT AN ESTABLISHMENT OF A CODE OF HONOR AND HONOR  
57 BOARD SHALL ENCOURAGE AND INSTILL THE VALUES OF  
58 INTEGRITY AND THE HONOR CONCERNING ACADEMIC AND  
59 PERSONAL AFFAIRS OF THEIR FELLOW STUDENT AND;  
60  
61 **PARAGRAPH 10:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA  
62 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND  
63 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT A CODE  
64 OF HONOR AND HONOR BAORD BE ESTABLISHED AT LOUISIANA  
65 STATE UNIVERSITY AND;

67 **PARAGRAPH 11:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS  
68 RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO THE OFFICE OF THE  
69 DEAN OF STUDENTS, THE OFFICE OF STUDENT ADVOCACY AND  
70 ACCOUNTABILITY, AND THE OFFICE OF THE LSU SYSTEM  
71 PRESIDENT, DR. KING ALEXANDER.  
72  
73 **PARAGRAPH 12:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A  
74 SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE  
75 AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR  
76 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND  
77 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF  
78 SUCH APPROVAL.
