8 **TO URGE AND REQUEST LSU DINING TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO OUTTAKES AND**
9 **THE TAKE FIVE BASED UPON STUDENT INPUT.**

10 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, LSU DINING’S MISSION STATEMENT STATES “LSU
11 DINING IS COMMITTED TO DELIVERING SUPERIOR SERVICE IN THE
12 MOST EFFICIENT WAY FOR THE SHARED BENEFIT OF OUR
13 STUDENTS, CAMPUS COMMUNITY, AND ASSOCIATES.”; AND,

14 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE NEEDS OF STUDENTS AT LOUISIANA STATE
15 UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE
16 (LSU) ARE BEST MET WHEN THEIR DIRECT INPUT IS USED IN THE
17 DELIBERATIVE PROCESS; AND,

18 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, INDEPENDENT SURVEYS (AN UNOFFICIAL SURVEY OF
19 STUDENTS DONE IN OCTOBER 2013 BY SENATOR R. LANCON)
20 REVEAL MANY NEEDS AND REQUEST OF LSU STUDENTS IN
21 REGARDS TO LSU DINING’S OUTTAKES AND TAKE FIVE
22 LOCATIONS; AND,

23 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, STRONG CONCERNS OF THE STUDENTS WERE TO
24 INSTALL A QUARTER MACHINE FOR LAUNDRY SERVICES, A
25 REDBOX MOVIE RENTAL KIOSK AND TIGERCASH MACHINES TO
26 IMPROVE BOTH LOCATIONS AND STUDENT LIFE; AND,

27 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, AMONG THE 85 (EIGHTY-FIVE) TOTAL STUDENTS
28 SURVEYED CONCERN WAS EXPRESSED THAT THE LOCATIONS,
29 WITHIN BOTH MAJOR RESIDENTIAL AREAS, BE OPEN ON FRIDAYS
30 AND SATURDAYS TO ALLOW FOR CONVENIENCE AND SAFETY FOR
31 STUDENTS; AND,

32 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE TOP CONCERNS FOR FOOD AND BEVERAGE
33 OPTIONS INCLUDE ICEE MACHINES, VEGETARIAN OPTIONS AND
34 LACTOSE-FREE OPTIONS AND EXPANDED COFFEE CHOICES; AND,

35 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, LSU DINING IS TO BE COMMENDED ON THEIR
36 PREVIOUS EFFORTS TO GATHER FEEDBACK VIA THEIR WEBSITE
37 AND THROUGH THE DINING ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

38 **PARAGRAPH 8:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
39 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
40 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT LSU
41 DINING IS URGED TO OFFICIALLY SURVEY STUDENTS IN ORDER TO
42 MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO THEIR OUTTAKES AND TAKE FIVE
43 LOCATIONS IN ADDITION TO OFFERING SERVICE HOURS ON
44 FRIDAY AND SATURDAY NIGHTS; AND,
