7 A BILL

8 TO AMEND THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT RULES OF ORDER

9 PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, CLARIFICATION IS NECESSARY FOR FUTURE
10 REFERENCE; AND,

11 PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 2 OF
12 THE RULES OF ORDER SHALL BE MADE:

13 Rule 2.3 Speaker Duties

- 14 A. To open the meetings promptly at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesdays during regular session.
- 15 B. To cause the Senate to proceed with its business in the proper order under the rules, if a
- 16 quorum is present, and to proceed upon each order of business.
- 17 C. To preserve order and decorum of the Senate.
- 18 D. To decide all points of order, subject to appeal to the Senate.
- 19 E. To explain or clarify any rule of procedure upon request.
- 20 F. To state each motion as it is made.
- 21 G. To recognize members who seek the floor for the purpose of speaking in debate or
- 22 otherwise.
- 23 H. To state and put to vote all questions requiring a vote, and all questions upon which a
- 24 vote is ordered, and to announce the vote.
- 25 I. To sign all documents which require his/her signature.
- 26 J. To appoint the Parliamentarian, Sergeant-at-Arms, Secretary, Undersecretary, Director
- 27 of Communications and any additional Legislative staff, subject to approval by the
- 28 Student Senate.
- 29 K. To be ultimately responsible for the processing of Senate-approved legislation, and to
- 30 see that the legislation reaches the executive office within two (2) class days of passage.
- 31 L. To chair the Spring Organizational Session until the election of the new Speaker.
- 32 M. To do and perform such other duties as may be required by the Constitution and Bylaws
- 33 of the Student Government.

34 PARAGRAPH 3: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA
35 STATE UNIVERSITY AND AGRICULTURAL AND
36 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THESE
37 AMENDMENTS BE ADOPTED.

38 PARAGRAPH 4: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
39 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY
40 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
41 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
42 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
