15 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, MIDDLETON LIBRARY CURRENTLY HAS CELL PHONE
16 CHARGING STATIONS POSITIONED WITHIN THE LIBRARY ,AND;

18 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THERE ARE NO MORE THAN TWO TO THREE SEATS
19 AVAILABLE AROUND EVERY STATION, HOWEVER THERE ARE
20 EIGHT CHARGERS AVAILABLE , AND;

22 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, IT IS DIFFICULT TO CHARGE MORE THAN TWO OR
23 THREE CELL PHONES AT A TIME WITHOUT LEAVING THEM
24 UNATTENDED ,AND;

26 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, IN ORDER TO ELIMINATE THIS ISSUE, FOUR HUNDRED
27 SIXTY DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$460.00) WILL BE ALLOCATED
28 TO PURCHASE CELL PHONE CHARGERS THAT WILL BE AVAILABLE
29 FOR ALL LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND
30 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENTS TO CHECK-OUT ,AND;

43 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, MIDDLETON LIBRARY ALREADY HAS A SYSTEM IN
44 PLACE FOR ELECTRONIC MATERIALS TO BE AVAILABLE FOR TWO

47 **PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THE OVERDUE CHARGE FOR TWO-HOUR RESERVE
48 MATERIALS IS \$1.50 PER HOUR, UP TO \$20.00. IF THE ITEM IS NOT
49 RETURNED BY THE FOLLOWING DAY, THE STUDENT WOULD BE
50 CHARGED A \$30.00 SERVICE CHARGE AND THE REPLACEMENT
51 COST OF THE CHARGER

54 **PARAGRAPH 9:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA
55 STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND
56 MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT FOUR
57 HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$460.00) BE
58 ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT SENATE
59 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF THIRTY
60 (30) PHONE CHARGERS TO BE AVAILABLE FOR CHECK-OUT FROM
61 MIDDLETON LIBRARY.

63 **PARAGRAPH 10:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS
64 (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY
65 THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL
66 ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY
67 APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
