A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$1,738.52) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEGISLATIVE GENERAL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE HISPANIC STUDENT CULTURAL SOCIETY (HSCS) FOR THEIR ANNUAL “DIA DEL NIÑO” EVENT

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE HSCS WAS ESTABLISHED TO PROMOTE A SENSE OF COMMUNITY AMONG HISPANIC STUDENTS AND BRING AWARENESS OF THE DIVERSITY AMONG HISPANIC CULTURES TO THE LSU COMMUNITY THROUGH EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING, EVENTS, AND COMMUNITY SERVICE AS WELL AS SUPPORT AND ASSIST IN THE ACCLIMATION OF PROSPECTIVE AND NEW HISPANIC STUDENTS TO LSU, AND;

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND FIVE STUDENTS WHO IDENTIFIED AS HISPANIC REPRESENT ABOUT 4 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT BODY AT LSU, EQUALING THE PERCENTAGE OF THE LOUISIANA RESIDENTS WHO IDENTIFIED AS HISPANIC IN THE 2010 CENSUS, AND;

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, RECOGNIZING THE GROWTH IN OUR HISPANIC STUDENT POPULATION HAS BEEN IMPORTANT FOR US TO HELP CULTIVATE A THRIVING HISPANIC STUDENT COMMUNITY AT LSU, AND;

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THEIR ANNUAL “DIA DEL NIÑO”, TRANSLATED AS DAY OF THE KIDS, IS AN EVENT IN WHICH STUDENTS ARE ABLE TO HAVE A CARNIVAL EXPERIENCE WHILE DONATING MONEY OR TOYS TO BENEFIT LESS FORTUNATE CHILDREN, AND;

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, EVERY YEAR THIS EVENT HAS TAKEN PLACE ON THE PARADE GROUND AND FEATURED INFLATABLE GAMES, A POPCORN MACHINE, REFRESHMENTS, AND MUSIC OPEN TO ALL GUEST, AND;

PARAGRAPH 6: WHEREAS, THE HSCS USES THIS ANNUAL EVENT TO GIVE BACK TO HISPANIC CHILDREN AS PART OF THEIR SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY, AND THE PLACES THEY HAVE DONATED TO IN THE PAST HAVE GREATLY APPRECIATED THEIR EFFORTS, AND;

PARAGRAPH 7: WHEREAS, THIS EXPENDITURE WOULD COVER THE FOLLOWING ACQUISITIONS:

PARAGRAPH 8: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FORTY EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY-TWO CENTS (\$1,738.52) FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT LEGISLATIVE GENERAL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE HISPANIC STUDENT CULTURAL SOCIETY (HSCS) FOR THEIR ANNUAL "DIA DEL NIÑO" EVENT.

PARAGRAPH 9: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
