10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **TO REESTABLISH AND REAFFIRM THE COMMITMENT TO HONOR, FORMERLY KNOWN**
12 **AS THE TIGER CREED/PLEDGE OF HONOR, AND TO URGE LOUISIANA STATE**
13 **UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE (LSU) TO RECOGNIZE THE**
14 **COMMITMENT TO HONOR AS A SUBSECTION OF THE COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY**

16 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE TIGER CREED/PLEDGE OF HONOR WAS
17 ESTABLISHED IN THE SPRING OF 2014; AND

18
19 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE FACULTY SENATE PASSED A RESOLUTION
20 SUPPORTING THE TIGER CREED; AND

21
22 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, ALTHOUGH BOTH RESOLUTIONS WERE PASSED THE
23 IMPLEMENTATION WAS NEVER CARRIED OUT; AND

25 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE INITIATIVE FELL BY THE WAY SIDE; AND

27 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THIS RESOLUTION AIMS TO REESTABLISH THIS
28 INITIATIVE; AND

30 **PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE COMMITMENT TO HONOR AIMS TO ESTABLISH A
31 BETTER ACADEMIC ATMOSPHERE; AND

33 **PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, THE GOAL OF THIS INTIATIVE IS TO HAVE STUDENTS
34 HOLDING STUDENTS TO HIGHER ACADEMIC STANDARDS; AND

36 **PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THIS COMMITMENT WILL WORK IN CONJUNCTION
37 WITH THE COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY; AND

39 **PARAGRAPH 9:** WHEREAS, THE CHANGES TO THE COMMITMENT TO HONOR ARE
40 AS FOLLOWS:

42 **Title: ~~LSU Tiger Creed~~ Commitment to Honor**

43
44 **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this shall be to establish an LSU Academic ~~Code of~~
45 **Commitment to Honor** for the University in order to cultivate an atmosphere of
46 academic integrity in association with our Commitment to Community to ~~represent the~~
47 ~~passion of loving purple, living gold, and upholding the~~ **demonstrate our pride in the**
48 **University and to uphold the tradition of excellence of at LSU.**

49
50 **BODY:**

51 "We, the students, faculty, and staff of Louisiana State University Agricultural and
52 Mechanical College, agree to uphold the following principles herein listed within this
53 ~~Code of~~ **Commitment to Honor** in a united effort to maintain a philosophy of academic
54 honesty, betterment, and accountability for all those within the LSU community.

56 We, the students, vow to act honorably in all academic coursework. As such:
57 1) We agree to neither give nor receive unpermitted aid in examinations,
58 reports, or any other work that is subject to the basis of grading
59 2) We agree to actively take part in upholding our neighbors to such a standard
60 prescribed in this ~~Code of~~ **Commitment to Honor**, including but not limited to,
61 the reporting of any violations in the spirit of this ~~Code~~ **Commitment**.

63 ~~We, the faculty and staff, vow to have utter confidence in the honor of all students. As~~
64 ~~such:~~

- 65 1) ~~We agree to refrain from pursuing unreasonable precautions to prevent forms~~
66 ~~of academic dishonesty and to maintain a level of trust and honor of the~~
67 ~~students' commitment to this code.~~
68 2) ~~We encourage methods of testing that foster upholding these principles listed~~
69 ~~within this Code.~~

70
71 Violations of these above principles will be considered a violation of this ~~Code of~~
72 **Commitment to Honor as well as the Code of Conduct**. Any offense of this type may
73 be reported by students, faculty, and staff to the office of Student Advocacy and
74 Accountability. Not reporting a potential violation of this ~~Code of~~ **Commitment to Honor**
75 in itself shall ~~not~~ be considered a violation to this ~~Code~~ **Commitment**, but rather a
76 violation of the upholding **as well as an encroachment on the spirit of** standards listed
77 **within set forth by** the Commitment to Community that unites LSU as an entity.

78
79 The establishment of this ~~Code of~~ **Commitment to Honor** acknowledges that all
80 students, faculty, and staff of Louisiana State University Agricultural and Mechanical
81 College agree to commit to **integrity and honor in all academic endeavors** excellence
82 and honor at all academic levels as well as personal integrity and responsibility.

83
84 Statement of acknowledgement of this ~~Code of~~ **Commitment to Honor**:

85
86 *"On my honor, I affirm that my academic endeavors are the product of my honest*
87 *efforts and I commit to hold myself and others to these academic standards as set*
88 *forth by LSU's Commitment to Honor. I have upheld the standards listed within the*
89 *Tiger Creed and that my academic work is the product of my sole unaided efforts"*

92 **PROCEDURES:**

93
94 This ~~LSU Code of Honor~~ **Commitment to Honor** shall be implemented immediately
95 upon its approval. Students shall be instructed on this ~~Code of Honor~~ **Commitment to**
96 **Honor** during their respective orientation period.

97
98 The ~~code of honor~~ **Commitment to Honor** can be amended by a two third majority vote
99 of the ~~code of honor~~ **Commitment to Honor** committee. The ~~code of~~ **Commitment to**
100 **Honor** committee can be convened at the request of the ~~office of~~ Student Advocacy
101 and Accountability or the Office of the Dean of Students. SAA or the Dean of Students
102 shall outline the structuring of this committee.

104 **PARAGRAPH 10:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA
105 STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE THAT THE
106 COMMITMENT TO HONOR BE REAFFIRMED AND REESTABLISHED BY
107 THE STUDENT SENATE AND THAT LSU INSTALLS THE
108 COMMITMENT TO HONOR AS A SUBSECTION TO THE
109 COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY

111 **PARAGRAPH 11:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A LETTER FURTHER
112 EXPLAINING THIS COMMITMENT BE CONSIDERED AN AUXILIARY
113 DOCUMENT TO THIS RESOLUTION,

115 **PARAGRAPH 12:** BE IT EVEN FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF
116 THIS RESOLUTION AND THE COMMITMENT TO
117 HONOR BE TRANSMITTED TO THE LSU FACULTY SENATE;
118 MARI FUENTES-MARTIN, ASSOCIATE VICE PRESIDENT AND
119 DEAN OF STUDENTS; RICHARD KOUBEK, INTERIM EXECUTIVE
120 VICE PRESIDENT AND PROVOST; JANE CASSIDY, SENIOR VICE
121 PROVOST; KURT KEPPLER, VICE PRESIDENT OF STUDENT LIFE
122 AND ENROLLMENT; AND F. KING ALEXANDER, LSU PRESIDENT.

124 **PARAGRAPH 13:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A
125 SIMPLE MAJORITY (ONE HALF PLUS ONE) VOTE OF THE LSU
126 STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON
127 LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE
128 PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON
129 THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
