A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THE TIGER CASH OFFICE, TO MAKE A TIGER CASH KIOSK AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS IN “THE FIVE” DINING HALL

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, CURRENTLY THERE ARE ONLY FOUR TIGER CASH KIOSKS ON CAMPUS; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THERE ARE VARIOUS MACHINES ON CAMPUS THAT REQUIRE TIGER CASH FOR SERVICE; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE PLACEMENT OF SAID KIOSK WOULD ALLOW THE CONVERSION OF CASH TO TIGER CASH; AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, STUDENTS HAVE VOICED THEIR DESIRES FOR MORE TIGER CASH KIOSKS ON CAMPUS; AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, IN THE SPRING SEMESTER THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE PASSED SGR No. 20, A RESOLUTION TO URGE AND REQUEST THE DEPARTMENT OF RESIDENTIAL LIFE TO MAKE TIGER CASH KIOSKS AVAILABLE TO ON-CAMPUS STUDENTS IN EACH OF THE RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITIES; AND

PARAGRAPH 6: WHEREAS, DUE TO THE PRICE OF SAID KIOSKS AND BUDGET CONCERNS THE PLACEMENT OF A KIOSK IN “THE FIVE” WOULD SERVE A SIMILAR PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ACCESS OF TIGER CASH TO A WIDE VARIETY OF STUDENTS, AND

PARAGRAPH 7: WHEREAS, IT WOULD BE BENEFICIAL FOR THE UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE TIGER CASH KIOSK FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF STUDENTS; AND

PARAGRAPH 8: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THE TIGER CASH OFFICE PLACE AN ADDITIONAL KIOSK IN “THE FIVE” DINING HALL; AND

PARAGRAPH 9: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO THE TIGER CASH OFFICE

PARAGRAPH 10: THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
