A RESOLUTION**TO URGE AND REQUEST THE ADMINISTRATION OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY TO
RECOGNIZE OCTOBER AS LGBT HISTORY MONTH**

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THERE IS A SIZABLE COMMUNITY OF LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, AND TRANSGENDER (LGBT) STUDENTS ON THE LSU CAMPUS, AND;
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE LSU FLAGSHIP DEFINES THE GOAL OF DIVERSITY AS "STRENGTHEN THE INTELLECTUAL ENVIRONMENT BY BROADENING THE CULTURAL DIVERSITY OF THE LSU COMMUNITY. INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO WORK WITH OR LIVE IN DIVERSE COMMUNITIES. EXPAND SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITIES FOR MINORITY, INTERNATIONAL, AND FIRST GENERATION STUDENTS." AND;
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE UNIVERSITY CURRENTLY RECOGNIZES BLACK HISTORY MONTH, WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH, AND HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH, AND;
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE NATIONAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZES OCTOBER AS LGBT HISTORY MONTH. AND;
- PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT OCTOBER BE RECOGNIZED AS LGBT HISTORY MONTH, AND;
- PARAGRAPH 6:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS BILL IS GIVEN TO CHANCELLOR MICHAEL MARTIN; KATRICE ALBERT, VICE PROVOST FOR EQUITY, DIVERSITY AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH ; KURT KEPPLER, VICE PROVOST FOR STUDENT LIFE & ENROLLMENT SERVICES; VICE PROVOST FOR ACADEMICS, PLANNING & REVIEW, T. GILMOUR REEVE; K.C. WHITE, DEAN OF STUDENTS; UNIVERSITY REGISTRAR ROBERT DOOLOS; ASSISTANT VICE CHANCELLOR FOR LEARNING AND TEACHING SAUNDRA MCGUIRE; CHAUNDA ALLEN, DIRECTOR OF OFFICE OF MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS,
- PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
