A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THAT ALL ACADEMIC DEPARTMENTS OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY USE THE TURNING TECHNOLOGIES RF CLICKER FOR IN CLASS PARTICIPATION AND QUIZZES

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, CURRENTLY STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE CLICKERS FOR CERTAIN CLASSES FOR PARTICIPATION AND QUIZ POINTS ;AND,
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, CURRENTLY THERE ARE TWO DIFFERENT CLICKERS IN USE AMONG DIFFERENT CLASSES AT THE UNIVERSITY; AND,
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE VAST MAJORITY OF CLASSES USE THE TURNING TECHNOLOGIES RF CLICKER; AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE ALTERNATE CLICKER USED BY INSTRUCTORS IS THE ICCLICKER, WHICH IS INCOMPATIBLE WITH THE TURNING TECHNOLOGIES SYSTEM; AND,
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, IT IS UNNECESSARY TO MAKE STUDENTS BEAR AN ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL BURDEN BY BUYING TWO CLICKERS WHEN IT WOULD BE MORE EFFICIENT FOR THERE TO BE A SINGLE UNIVERSITY WIDE CLICKER; AND,
- PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE FACULTY SENATE HAS ALSO OFFICIALLY ENCOURAGED THE FACULTY TO ADOPT THE TURNING TECHNOLOGIES RF CLICKER AS THE SOLE CLICKER OF THE UNIVERSITY; AND,
- PARAGRAPH 7:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT THE ACADEMIC DEPARTMENTS OF LSU TO ENDORSE THE TURNING TECHNOLOGIES CLICKER AS THE OFFICIAL CLICKER OF THE UNIVERSITY.
- PARAGRAPH 8:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
