A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THAT THE COMPUTER BASED TESTING CENTER IMPLEMENT AN ELECTRONIC CONSENT FORM VIA THE CAE SCHEDULING WEBSITE.

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, CURRENTLY STUDENTS MUST SIGN A CONSENT FORM AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH NEW SEMESTER IN ORDER TO TAKE TESTS IN THE CBTC; AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THIS RESULTS IN MANY THOUSANDS OF SIGNED CONSENT FORMS THAT MUST BE PRINTED AND ORGANIZED BY THE CBTC DEPARTMENT; AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THERE EXISTS CURRENTLY AN ONLINE WEBSITE FOR THE CBTC TO SCHEDULE TESTS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, EACH STUDENT THAT USES THE CBTC WEBSITE TO SCHEDULE TESTS HAS HIS OR HER OWN UNIQUE ID TO SIGN IN; AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE CBTC SHOULD USE THEIR ONLINE SCHEDULING WEBSITE TO ALSO INCORPORATE AN ELECTRONIC CONSENT FORM IDENTICAL TO THE PHYSICAL ONE ALREADY IN USE; AND
- PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, USING AN ELECTRONIC CONSENT FORM WOULD CUT BACK ON THE AMOUNT OF PAPER NEEDED TO BE BOUGHT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRINTING SAID FORMS, THUS AIDING IN CBTC FINANCES AND PROMOTING SUSTAINABILITY ON CAMPUS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, USING AN ELECTRONIC CONSENT FORM WOULD ALSO GREATLY AIDE IN THE ORGANIZING OF SAID FORMS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 8:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE URGES AND REQUESTS THAT THE COMPUTER BASED TESTING CENTER USE AN ELECTRONIC CONSENT FORM VIA THE CBTC SCHEDULING WEBSITE TO REPLACE THE CURRENT PHYSICAL FORM IN USE.
- PARAGRAPH 9:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A SUITABLE COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE FORWARDED TO BOBBY MATTHEWS, DIRECTOR OF THE COMPUTER BASED TESTING CENTER.
- PARAGRAPH 10:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT; UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION; OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE.
