A RESOLUTION

TO URGE AND REQUEST THAT STUDENTS HAVE TO READ AND ACCEPT THE LSU COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY AS A STEP IN PAYING THEIR LSU FEE BILL

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, CURRENTLY LSU STUDENTS ARE HELD TO THE STANDARDS OF THE LSU COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY; AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, MANY STUDENTS ARE IGNORANT TO THE EXISTENCE OF THE LSU COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY; AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, EVERY STUDENT ON CAMPUS HAS TO PAY OR CLICK FINISH ON THEIR FEE BILL; AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, IF EVERY STUDENT HAD TO READ AND ACCEPT THE COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY AWARENESS OF THE DOCUMENT WOULD INCREASE; AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, BY INCREASING THE AWARENESS OF SUCH A DOCUMENT WE CAN MAKE LSU A BETTER PLACE BY HAVING STUDENTS THAT ARE MORE DEDICATED TO THE LSU COMMUNITY AND ARE MORE AWARE OF THE HIGH STANDARD THE STUDENT ADVOCACY AND ACCOUNTABILITY OFFICE HOLDS THEM TOO; AND
- PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE THAT STUDENTS SHOULD HAVE TO READ AND ACCEPT THE LSU COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY AS A STEP IN PAYING THEIR LSU FEE BILL; AND
- PARAGRAPH 7:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO DEAN WHITE, DEAN OF STUDENTS; DR. MATT GREGORY, DIRECTOR OF STUDENT ADVOCACY AND ACCOUNTABILITY; LAURENCE S. BUTCHER, DIRECTOR OF THE BURSARS OFFICE; AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES.
- PARAGRAPH 8:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
