A RESOLUTION**TO URGE AND REQUEST THE CITY OF BATON ROUGE TO ADD AND IMPROVE
SIDEWALKS TO EAST BOYD DRIVE AND SURROUNDING AREAS**

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, MANY LSU STUDENT FREQUENTLY WALK ON THIS STREET FOR LIVING AND ENTERTAINMENT PURPOSES; AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THIS STREET CURRENTLY HAS NO SIDEWALKS, WHICH FORCE STUDENTS TO WALK ON OR VERY NEAR THE STREET; AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THIS CONDITION HAS CAUSED A SAFETY HAZARD FOR BOTH PEDESTRIANS AND DRIVERS, ESPECIALLY AT NIGHT; AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, MANY STUDENTS HAVE EXPERIENCED A NEAR COLLISION WITH VEHICLES; AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THREE (3) STUDENTS HAVE ALREADY BEEN HIT DUE TO THE LACK OF SIDEWALKS; AND
- PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, LSU STUDENTS ARE VOTING MEMBERS OF METRO COUNCIL DISTRICT AND OF THE CITY OF BATON ROUGE;
- PARAGRAPH 7:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE STUDENT SENATE URGE AND REQUEST THE CITY OF BATON ROUGE TO ADD AND IMPROVE SIDEWALKS TO EAST BOYD DRIVE.
- PARAGRAPH 8:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A SIMPLE MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
- PARAGRAPH 9:** UPON APPROVAL, COPIES OF THIS LEGISLATION SHALL BE SENT TO THE FOLLOWING: COUNCILMAN RODNEY "SMOKIE" BOURGEOIS, METRO COUNCIL OF BATON ROUGE, THE DIRECTOR OF RESIDENTIAL LIFE, MAYOR KIP HOLDEN, CHANCELLOR MICHAEL MARTIN, BATON ROUGE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, AND THE BATON ROUGE AREA CHAMBER.
