A FINANCE BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF \$3,500 (THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS) OF THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE LSU STUDENT CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN VETERINARY MEDICINE ASSOCIATION FOR THE 2011 SAVMA SYMPOSIUM IN DAVIS, CALIFORNIA ON MARCH 23-26 2011

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, FIFTY-EIGHT STUDENTS FROM THE LSU SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE WILL BE ATTENDING THE SAVMA SYMPOSIUM IN DAVIS, CALIFORNIA ON MARCH 23-26 2011; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THEY ARE REQUESTING FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$3,500) FROM THE SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO COVER THE COST OF REGISTRATION FOR THE EVENT; AND TO MATCH FUNDS DONATED BY THE LOUISIANA VETERINARY MEDICAL ASSOCIATION AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THIS SYMPOSIUM GIVES VETERINARY STUDENTS AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY TO EXPERIENCE VARIOUS FIELDS OF WORK AND RESEARCH THAT ARE AVAILABLE TO THEM UPON GRADUATION FROM LSU SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE.

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT A MAXIMUM OF THREE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$3,500) BE ALLOCATED TO THOSE STUDENTS ATTENDING THE 2011 SAVMA SYMPOSIUM

PARAGRAPH 5: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A 2/3 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL
