A BILL

TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$3,122.00) FROM THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE LSU STUDENT CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN VETERINARY MEDICINE ASSOCIATION FOR THE 2010 SAVMA SYMPOSIUM IN MADISON, WISCONSIN, ON MARCH 11-14, 2010.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, FORTY STUDENTS FROM THE LSU SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE WILL BE ATTENDING THE SAVMA SYMPOSIUM IN MADISON, WISCONSIN ON MARCH 11-14, 2010; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THEY ARE REQUESTING FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$3,122.00) FROM THE SENATE CONTINGENCY IN ORDER TO COVER THE COST OF REGISTRATION IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY DOLLARS (\$2,930.00), AND THE COST OF WETLABS IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED NINETY TWO DOLLARS (\$192.00); AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE WETLABS PROVIDE HANDS ON EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE FOR THE FORTY STUDENTS ;

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$3,122.00) FROM THE SENATE CONTINGENCY BE ALLOCATED TO THOSE STUDENTS ATTENDING THE 2010 SAVMA SYMPOSIUM.

PARAGRAPH 5: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A 2/3 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
