9 **TO URGE AND REQUEST THE LIBRARY TO ESTABLISH LATE NIGHT HOURS DURING THE**  
10 **CONCENTRATED STUDY PERIOD AND FINAL EXAMINATIONS TO ENHANCE THE STUDY**  
11 **ENVIRONMENT AND TO CREATE INCREASED OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS.**

15 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THIS SEMESTER LATE NIGHT HOURS WERE  
16 DISCONTINUED DUE TO THE REMOVAL OF FUNDING FOR THIS  
17 PROGRAM; AND

19 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, OVER THIS PAST SEMESTER, THE LIBRARY CLOSURE  
20 HAS BEEN MOVED FROM 2 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT; AND

22 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THIS SEMESTER, LIBRARY ADMINISTRATION HAS  
23 NOTICED AN INCREASE IN THE LIBRARY USAGE, ESPECIALLY  
24 DURING THE LATE NIGHT HOURS IMPLEMENTED FOR MIDTERM  
25 EXAMINATIONS WEEK; AND

27 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, DUE TO THIS INCREASE IN STUDENT USAGE, LIBRARY  
28 HOURS SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO LATER HOURS TO GIVE  
29 STUDENTS AS MANY OUTLETS TO FURTHER SUCCEED IN THEIR  
30 ACADEMIC ENDEAVORS; AND

32 **PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STUDENT  
33 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY  
34 AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE URGES  
35 AND REQUESTS THE LIBRARY ADMINISTRATION TO EXTEND THE  
36 HOURS FOR MIDDLETON LIBRARY DURING THE CONCENTRATED  
37 STUDY PERIOD AND FINAL EXAMINATIONS TO 24 HOURS FOR THE  
38 BETTERMENT OF EACH STUDENT'S OPPORTUNITY TO FURTHER  
39 SUCCEED ON THEIR EXAMINATIONS; AND

41 **PARAGRAPH 6:** BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT A SUITABLE COPY OF  
42 THIS RESOLUTION BE TRANSMITTED TO JENNIFER CARGILL,  
43 DEAN OF THE LIBRARY, ERIC MONDAY, INTERIM VICE  
44 CHANCELLOR FOR FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES;  
45 ASTRID MERGET, PROVOST; AND MICHAEL V. MARTIN,  
46 CHANCELLOR.

48 **PARAGRAPH 7:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON  
49 PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY (1/2) VOTE OF THE LSU  
50 STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE  
51 PRESIDENT; UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL  
52 ACTION; OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND  
53 SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE.
