9 **TO ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF THREE-THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS**  
10 **(\$3450) TO PURCHASE PORTABLE DRY ERASE BOARDS FOR THE UNION.**

12 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, OTHER UNIVERSITIES SUCH AS UNIVERSITY OF  
13 KENTUCKY AND UNIVERSITY TENNESSEE HAVE SIMILAR WHITE  
14 BOARDS AVAILABLE FOR THEIR STUDENTS, AND

16 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THEY CREATE AN ACADEMIC ENVIRONMENT THAT  
17 ENHANCES THE EFFECTIVENESS OF STUDENT'S STUDYING  
18 EFFORTS BY ALLOWING THEM TO WORK PROBLEMS, DRAW  
19 GRAPHS, OR MAKE NOTES ON THE WHITE BOARD.

21 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE BREAKDOWN OF COSTS IS AS FOLLOWS:

- 23 a. 5 DRY ERASE BOARDS AT \$650 PER BOARD
- 24 TOTALING \$3250.
- 25 b. \$200 FOR SHIPPING

27 **PARAGRAPH 4:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT  
28 SENATE WILL ALLOCATE A MAXIMUM OF THREE THOUSAND  
29 FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$3450) FROM THE SENATE  
30 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO PURCHASE PORTABLE DRY ERASE  
31 BOARDS FOR THE UNION.

33 **PARAGRAPH 5:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS  
34 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE  
35 PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR  
36 IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY  
37 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
