9 **TO ALLOCATE TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$2,160.00) FROM THE**  
10 **STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO SIX MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL**  
11 **ASSOCIATION OF WOMEN MBAS-LSU CHAPTER TO ATTEND THE NATIONAL**  
12 **ASSOCIATION OF WOMEN MBAS NATIONAL CONFERENCE IN CONNECTICUT FROM**  
13 **OCTOBER 23<sup>RD</sup>-25<sup>TH</sup>.**

16 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF WOMAN MBAS  
17 (NAWMBA) IS AN ORGANIZATION THAT USES EDUCATION,  
18 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT, NETWORKING, AND  
19 COLLABORATION TO PROPEL MORE WOMEN INTO LEADERSHIP  
20 POSITIONS IN CORPORATE AMERICA AND TO ENHANCE THE  
21 DIVERSITY OF THE NATION’S WORKFORCE; AND

23 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE ORGANIZATION’S NATIONAL CONFERENCE IS  
24 HELD THIS YEAR IN STAMFORD, CONNECTICUT, WHICH ALLOWS  
25 THE ATTENDEES TO MEET WITH COMPANIES, PRE-APPLY TO  
26 POSTED JOBS, AND RECEIVE TRAINING IN INTERVIEWING AND  
27 RESUME SKILLS; AND

29 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, THE ORGANIZATION WILL NOT RECEIVE FUNDS  
30 FROM THE GRADUATE SCHOOL BECAUSE THE CONFERENCE DOES  
31 NOT QUALIFY AS A RESEARCH CONFERENCE; AND

33 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS  
34 (\$360.00) WILL HELP FUND SIX MEMBERS’ REGISTRATION, AND  
35 ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,800.00) WILL HELP  
36 FUND SIX MEMBERS’ FLIGHTS TO STAMFORD.

38 **PARAGRAPH 5:** THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT  
39 GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY  
40 AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT  
41 TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$2,160.00) BE  
42 ALLOCATED FROM THE STUDENT SENATE CONTINGENCY  
43 ACCOUNT TO SIX MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF  
44 WOMEN MBAS-LSU CHAPTER TO ATTEND THE NATIONAL  
45 ASSOCIATION OF WOMEN MBAS NATIONAL CONFERENCE.

47 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON  
48 PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU  
49 STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE  
50 PRESIDENT; UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR  
51 PRESIDENTIAL ACTION; OR IF VETOED BY THE  
52 PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE  
53 SENATE.
