8 **To AMEND ARTICLE IX OF THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT**
9 **GOVERNMENT BYLAWS BY ADDING A NEW SECTION IN ORDER TO CREATE THE CLASS**
10 **GIFT COMMITTEE**

11 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY A&M
12 STUDENT GOVERNMENT HAS FUNDED A BEAUTIFICATION
13 PROJECT IN THE WEST DODSON COURTYARD ; AND

14 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE INTENT OF THIS PROJECT IS TO CREATE THE
15 TRADITION OF ANNUAL CLASS GIFTS TO BE MADE BY THE SENIORS;
16 AND

17 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO ESTABLISH A COMMITTEE
18 TO FACILITATE THE SELECTION OF THE PROJECTS THAT WILL BE
19 PRESENTED TO THE JUNIOR CLASS; AND

20 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, ARTICLE IX, SECTION 3 WILL SAY:

21 **3. CLASS GIFT COMMITTEE**

- 22 **a.** THIS COMMITTEE WILL BE COMPRISED OF SEVEN (7)
23 JUNIOR STUDENTS ELECTED FROM THE STUDENT
24 BODY. NO MORE THAN TWO STUDENTS MAY SIT ON
25 THIS COMMITTEE FROM THE SAME COLLEGE.
- 26 **b.** THE DIRECTOR OF DEVELOPMENT IN STUDENT
27 LIFE, AS WELL AS THE MANAGER OF FACILITY
28 DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT WILL SERVE AS EX-
29 OFFICIO OFFICERS OF THE COMMITTEE.
- 30 **c.** NO MORE THAN THREE STUDENTS THAT
31 CURRENTLY HOLD OFFICE WITHIN STUDENT
32 GOVERNMENT MAY SIT ON THIS COMMITTEE.
- 33 **d.** POSITIONS FOR THIS COMMITTEE WILL BE
34 ADVERTISED ACROSS ALL NECESSARY MEDIUMS AND
35 MEMBERS SHALL BE ELECTED BY THE STUDENT
36 GOVERNMENT SENATE DURING THE SPRING
37 ORGANIZATIONAL SESSION.
- 38 **e.** SHOULD A VACANCY ARISE, THE SPEAKER OF THE
39 SENATE SHALL APPOINT A STUDENT TO BE
40 APPROVED BY THE SENATE.
- 41 **f.** THE CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE A
42 MEMBER OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT SENATE
43 TO BE APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER AND APPROVED
44 BY THE SENATE.
- 45 **g.** IT SHALL BE THE DUTY OF THIS COMMITTEE TO
46 GATHER POTENTIAL CLASS GIFT PROJECTS THAT
47 ARE APPROVED BY THE FACILITY DESIGN &

DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE AND RECOMMEND NO MORE THAN FOUR (4) AND NO LESS THAN TWO (2) DESIGNS TO THE SENATE SO THAT THEY MAY BE PLACED ON THE SPRING ELECTION BALLOT BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION.

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT ARTICLE IX OF THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS BE SO AMENDED TO CREATE THE CLASS GIFT COMMITTEE.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
