A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO CAREER SERVICES FOR THEIR SPRING SEMESTER CAREER EXPO

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, EACH SEMESTER CAREER SERVICES HOLDS A "CAREER EXPO" WHERE STUDENTS OF ALL MAJORS ARE INVITED TO MEET REPRESENTATIVES FROM DIFFERENT CORPORATIONS AROUND THE COUNTRY; AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, LAST SEMESTER OVER 200 DIFFERENT CORPORATIONS WERE REPRESENTED AND COUNTLESS STUDENTS TOOK ADVANTAGE OF THIS INCREDIBLE NETWORKING OPPORTUNITY; AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, MANY STUDENTS USE THE SPRING CAREER EXPO, IN PARTICULAR, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINDING SUMMER JOBS AND INTERNSHIPS; AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, IT IS THE POLICY OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT GOVERNMENT TO AID IN THE PRODUCTION OF ANY PROGRAMMING THAT DIRECTLY BENEFITS ITS CONSTITUENCY WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE THAT FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS BE APPROPRIATED FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO CAREER SERVICES FOR THEIR SPRING SEMESTER CAREER EXPO.

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY (1/2 PLUS 1) VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
