A RESOLUTION

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, DR. JENKINS CONTINUES TO SERVE THE LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM IN THE CAPACITY OF PRESIDENT EMERITUS.
