12 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, HURRICANE KATRINA CAUSED SEVERE DAMAGE TO
13 RESIDENTIAL AREAS OF NEW ORLEANS, AND

15 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, NEW ORLEANS IS UNDERGOING A CONTINUING
16 REBUILDING PROCESS, AND

18 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, STUDENT GOVERNMENT IS COMMITED TO ADVANCING
19 THE UNIVERSITY'S AGENDA FOR PUBLIC SERVICE, AND

21 **PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, STUDENT GOVERNMENT AND VOLUNTEER LSU ARE
22 MEETING AN IMPORTANT STUDENT NEED BY COSPONSORING A
23 SERVICE PROJECT IN NEW ORLEANS THAT WILL GIVE STUDENTS
24 THE OPPORTUNITY TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE REVITALIZATION OF

27 **PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, FOUR BUSES WILL BE NEEDED TO TRANSPORT MORE
28 THAN 200 STUDENT, FACULTY AND STAFF VOLUNTEERS TO NEW
29 ORLEANS ON OCTOBER 28, 2006 TO ASSIST IN REVITALIZATION

32 **PARAGRAPH 6:** THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT
33 SENATE WILL ALLOCATE \$5,292 FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT
34 INITIATIVES ACCOUNT TO FUND THIS IMPORTANT SERVICE
35 OPPORTUNITY.

38 VOTE OF THE LSU STUDENT SENATE AND SIGNATURE BY THE
39 PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR
40 IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY
41 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
