15 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, ANTOINE JEFFERSON, PATRICK VOORHIES, AND  
16 JENNIFER MADER, MEMBERS OF COLLEGIATE 4-H AT LSU, PLAN  
17 TO ATTEND THE SOUTHERN REGIONAL COLLEGIATE 4-H  
18 CONFERENCE IN LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS AND

20 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THERE IS A NEED TO FUND SUCH INITIATIVES AS IT  
21 WILL REPRESENT THE UNIVERSITY IN A POSITIVE MANNER ON THE  
22 NATIONAL STAGE, AND ENRICH THE LEVEL OF EDUCATION FOR  
23 THE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS ATTENDING THE CONFERENCE,

37 ATTENDANCE OF ANTOINE JEFFERSON, PATRICK VOORHIES, AND
