13 **PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE PHI SIGMA PI HONOR FRATERNITY OF LSU,
14 OPEN TO ALL QUALIFYING LSU STUDENTS, SERVES OUR CAMPUS
15 COMMUNITY BASED ON SCHOLARSHIP, LEADERSHIP, AND
16 FELLOWSHIP, AND

18 **PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, PHI SIGMA PI HAS BEEN NATIONALLY ACCLAIMED FOR
19 THEIR WORK WITH TEACH FOR AMERICA, AND

21 **PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, PHI SIGMA PI WILL REQUIRE FUNDS FOR CONFERENCE
22 REGISTRATION AND LODGING TO SEND TWENTY-FOUR MEMEBRS
23 TO THE 2006 NATIONAL CONVENTION ON NOVEMBER 17 – 19,

33 PRESIDENT, UPON LAPSE OF TIME FOR PRESIDENTIAL ACTION, OR
34 IF VETOED BY THE PRESIDENT AND SUBSEQUENTLY APPROVED BY
35 THE SENATE, ON THE DATE OF SUCH APPROVAL.
