A BILL

TO AMEND ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3 OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ELECTION CODE AS IT RELATES TO "UNSOLICITED E-MAILS TO STUDENTS"

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION E OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ELECTION CODE WAS HASTILY ADDED LESS THAN A YEAR AGO TO DISALLOW CAMPAIGNING THROUGH "UNSOLICITED" E-MAIL TO STUDENTS, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THIS BAN ON E-MAIL IS NOT ONLY VAGUE IN ITS WORDING AND IMPRACTICAL, BUT A HINDERANCE ON FREE SPEECH.

PARAGRAPH 3: THEREFORE, ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION E OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ELECTION CODE IS HEREBY REPEALED, AND SHALL BE REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

E. ANY METHOD THAT VIOLATES UNIVERSITY OR STATE POLICY CONCERNING MASS E-MAIL SENT THROUGH UNIVERSITY SERVERS.

PARAGRAPH 4: THIS LEGISLATION SHALL TAKE EFFECT TWO (2) SEMESTERS, EXCLUDING SUMMERS, FOLLOWING PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE.
