A RESOLUTION

**TO AFFIRM THE PERMANENT LOCATION OF THE HORTICULTURE HILL FARM
TEACHING FACILITY ON THE LSU A&M CAMPUS**

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, LSU IS AN AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE, AS WELL AS A LAND GRANT UNIVERSITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, ON-CAMPUS TEACHING FACILITIES ARE CRUCIAL TO STUDENT LEARNING IN EVERY FIELD OF ENDEAVOR, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE HORTICULTURE HILL FARM TEACHING FACILITY HAS DECREASED IN SIZE FROM FORTY (40) ACRES TO FIVE (5), AND THE LSU MASTER PLAN MAY CALL FOR MORE LAND TO BE TAKEN FROM IT.

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE ENCOURAGES THE UNIVERSITY ADMINISTRATION TO PROVIDE PERMANENT SPACE FOR STUDENT LEARNING AT AN ON-CAMPUS HORTICULTURAL SITE, BY AGREEING NOT TO DECREASE (WHILE NOT RULING OUT THE POSSIBLE INCREASE OF) THE SIZE OF THE HORTICULTURE HILL FARM TEACHING FACILITY.
