A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00) TO ARMY SCOTCHGUARD PROVIDING FOR BANNERS TO BE PLACED ON THE LSU CAMPUS FOR THE '2000 JAIL-N-BAIL' FUNDRAISER FOR THE MARCH OF DIMES.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, ARMY SCOTCHGUARD IS AN OFFICIAL ORGANIZATION ON THE CAMPUS OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, ARMY SCOTCHGUARD REPRESENTS LSU TO THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY THROUGH VARIOUS FACETS, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, ARMY SCOTCHGUARD IS IN NEED OF FUNDING FOR THE PUBLICITY OF THE SECOND ANNUAL 'JAIL-N-BAIL' MARCH OF DIMES FUNDRAISER.

PARAGRAPH 4: THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HEREBY PROVIDES FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00) TO ARMY SCOTCHGUARD FOR BANNERS IN THE SECOND ANNUAL 'JAIL-N-BAIL' MARCH OF DIMES FUNDRAISER .

PARAGRAPH 5: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2001.
