A BILL

TO AMEND ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION C OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT GOVERNMENT ELECTION CODE AS IT PERTAINS TO PROHIBITED METHODS OF CAMPAIGNING.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION C CURRENTLY READS:

“ADVERTISING ON COMMERCIAL RADIO OR TELEVISION.”

PARAGRAPH 2: THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE AMENDS ARTICLE IV, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION C OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ELECTION CODE TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

“ADVERTISING ON ANY RADIO, NEWSPAPER OR TELEVISION MEDIUM.”

PARAGRAPH 3: THIS BILL SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE TWO (2) SEMESTERS, EXCLUDING SUMMERS, FOLLOWING PASSAGE BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE STUDENT SENATE.
