A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$4,830.00) TO THE LSU CHAPTER OF BETA XI OF PI SIGMA EPSILON (PSE) TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF SENDING TWENTY-THREE (23) STUDENTS/DELEGATES TO THE 2001 PI SIGMA EPSILON ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION MARCH 27TH-APRIL 1ST IN DALLAS, TX.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE BETA XI CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA EPSILON IS AN OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION AT LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE BETA XI CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA EPSILON IS A CO-ED, NATIONAL, PROFESSIONAL, MARKETING, SALES MANAGEMENT AND SELLING FRATERNITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, BETA XI IS CURRENTLY RANKED #1 IN THE NATION AMONG ALL OTHER 51 ACTIVE PSE CHAPTERS THROUGHOUT THE NATION, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, BETA XI IS THE MOST ACTIVE BUSINESS ORGANIZATION ON CAMPUS AND WORKS YEAR ROUND FOR THIS ONE WEEK OF COMPETITION TO TRY AND TAKE HOME THE TOP CHAPTER TROPHY, AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, LAST YEAR THE BETA XI CHAPTER WENT TO ANAHEIM, CA AND TOOK HOME MORE AWARDS THAN ANY OTHER CHAPTER IN THE NATION OF WHICH WERE THE TOP SALES AWARD, THE TOP MARKETING RESEARCH AWARD, THE TOP ALUMNI ADVISOR AWARD, THE TOP SALES AND MARKETING EXECUTIVES AWARD, AND THIRD PLACE IN THE MULTIMEDIA POWER POINT SLIDE SHOW PRESENTATION, AND

PARAGRAPH 6: WHEREAS, THE STUDENTS ATTENDING CONVENTION WILL BE REPRESENTING L.S.U. AND WILL BE COMPETING AROUND THE CLOCK AND GIVING PRESENTATIONS OF THE WORK THEY ACCOMPLISHED THIS PAST YEAR. THE STUDENTS ATTENDING WILL ALSO GAIN VALUABLE EXPERIENCE FROM MOCK INTERVIEWS, RESUME WORKSHOPS, SALES COMPETITIONS, BRIEFINGS FROM PROFESSIONAL SALES PEOPLE WHO WORK IN CORPORATE AMERICA TODAY AND MORE, AND

PARAGRAPH 7: WHEREAS, THE BETA XI CHAPTER HAS NEVER SOLICITED FUNDS FOR CONVENTION THROUGH L.S.U. STUDENT GOVERNMENT AND HAS ALWAYS USED ITS ANNUAL REVENUE AND O.R.F. AS A SOURCE OF HELP, AND

PARAGRAPH 8: WHEREAS, DESPITE CONTRIBUTIONS AND INDIVIDUAL OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSE, THESE STUDENTS STILL FALL SHORT OF THE TOTAL FUNDS NECESSARY FOR COMPETITION AT CONVENTION, AND

PARAGRAPH 9: WHEREAS, BETA XI WILL NEED APPROXIMATELY \$16,310.85 TOTAL AND USE THE REVENUE IT HAS GENERATED YEAR ROUND AS WELL AS THE HELP FROM O.R.F. TO COVER OTHER EXPENSES.

PARAGRAPH 10: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS (\$4,830.00) TO THE BETA XI CHAPTER OF PI SIGMA EPSILON TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF SENDING STUDENTS/ DELEGATES TO THE 2001 PI SIGMA EPSILON ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION.

PARAGRAPH 11: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE.

PARAGRAPH 12: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2001.
