A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600.00) TO THE BUSINESS COLLEGE COUNCIL TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF RENTING THE LOD COOK ALUMNI CENTER FOR THE FALL 1999 CAREER RECEPTION

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE CAREER RECEPTION IS AN EVENT WHICH DIRECTLY BENEFITS THE STUDENTS OF LSU, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, DESPITE DILIGENT FUND RAISING EFFORTS BY THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS, A BUDGET SHORTFALL HAS OCCURRED, COMPROMISING THE ABILITY FOR THE BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION COLLEGE COUNCIL TO FUND THE EVENT.

PARAGRAPH 3: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HEREBY APPROPRIATES SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600.00) TO THE BUSINESS COLLEGE COUNCIL TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF RENTING THE LOD COOK ALUMNI CENTER FOR THE FALL 1999 CAREER RECEPTION.

PARAGRAPH 4: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2000.
