**A BILL**

TO APPROPRIATE ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-SIX DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$1646.40) TO THE LSU A&M CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF ARCHITECTURE STUDENTS (AIAS) TO DEFRAY COSTS FOR LODGING FOR MEMBERS ATTENDING THE NATIONAL FORUM TO BE HELD IN TORONTO, CANADA.

**PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LSU A&M CHAPTER OF THE AIAS HAS BEEN A RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION FOR FORTY-SEVEN YEARS, AND

**PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE COST OF TWO QUADRUPLE-OCCUPANCY ROOMS FOR SEVEN NIGHTS IS ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-SIX DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$1646.40), AND

**PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, EACH OF THE EIGHT MEMBERS ATTENDING HAS FINANCED HIS OR HER OWN TRANSPORTATION, TOTALING ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE DOLLARS AND TWELVE CENTS (\$1995.12), AND

**PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, THE MEMBERS' REGISTRATION TOTALING ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$1336) HAS BEEN PAID FOR BY THE STANDING SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE BUDGET MONIES AND PRIVATE FUND-RAISING, AND

**PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, FORUM IS THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION'S KEYSTONE EVENT WHERE NATIONAL OFFICERS WILL BE ELECTED AND BIDS WILL BE TAKEN FOR THE EVENT LOCATION IN THE YEAR 2001, AND

**PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, AT LEAST ONE LSU A&M CHAPTER MEMBER IS RUNNING FOR NATIONAL DIRECTOR FOR THE SOUTH QUADRANT AND ONE IS RUNNING FOR THE NATIONAL ARCHITECTURE ACCREDITATION BOARD, AND

**PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, THE LSU A&M CHAPTER IS COLLABORATING WITH TULANE UNIVERSITY AS CO-HOSTS TO BID FOR FORUM 2001 TO BE HELD IN NEW ORLEANS, AND

**PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, INVOLVEMENT IN THESE TWO FACETS OF THE EVENT IS A MAJOR OPPORTUNITY TO PROMOTE LSU A&M AND ITS STUDENT BODY.

**PARAGRAPH 9:** THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE APPROPRIATES ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY-SIX DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$1646.40) TO THE LSU A&M CHAPTER OF THE AIAS TO PAY FOR LODGING FOR MEMBERS ATTENDING THE NATIONAL FORUM TO BE HELD IN TORONTO, CANADA.

**PARAGRAPH 10:** ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2000.
