A BILL

TO AMEND THE LSU A&M STUDENT GOVERNMENT BYLAWS, ARTICLE VI, SECTION 16

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, PRESENT FINANCIAL RESOURCES MAKE IT ADVISABLE TO LIMIT INDIVIDUAL ALLOCATIONS SO AS TO AFFORD GREATER OPPORTUNITY TO STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, CURRENT BYLAWS ALREADY ENCOURAGE THE SELF GENERATION OF FUNDS BY STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THERE IS NO CURRENT LIMIT ON THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS A STUDENT ORGANIZATION CAN REQUEST, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE AVERAGE ALLOCATION OF STUDENT FUNDS FOR THE 1998-1999 FISCAL YEAR WAS SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-TWO DOLLARS AND THIRTY-FIVE CENTS. (\$792.35),

PARAGRAPH 5: THEREFORE, IN ORDER TO ALLOW A GREATER NUMBER OF APPROPRIATIONS TO BE AVAILABLE TO STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS,

ARTICLE VI, SECTION 16, SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

“D. THE STUDENT SENATE SHALL NOT MAKE ANY FISCAL APPROPRIATION GREATER THAN ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000) DOLLARS FOR ANY SINGLE BILL, UNLESS APPROVED BY A $\frac{3}{4}$ MAJORITY.”

PARAGRAPH 6: THIS BILL SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE BY PASSAGE OF A $\frac{3}{4}$ VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE.
