A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$1,190) TO THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS TO HELP DEFRAY THE COST OF HOTEL ROOMS FOR THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BLACK ENGINEERS 26TH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS HAS BEEN A REGISTERED STUDENT ORGANIZATION SINCE 1983, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE ORGANIZATION'S MISSION IS TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CULTURALLY RESPONSIBLE BLACK ENGINEERS WHO EXCEL ACADEMICALLY, SUCCEED PROFESSIONALLY, AND POSITIVELY IMPACT THE COMMUNITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BLACK ENGINEERS 26TH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION HELPS TO PROMOTE THESE GOALS, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF REGISTRATION, REMAINING AIRFARE, AND SHUTTLE SERVICE TOTALING THREE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$350) PER PERSON, AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, THE TOTAL COST FOR HOTEL ROOMS IS THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$3,840), AND

PARAGRAPH 6: WHEREAS, MINORITY ENGINEERING PROGRAMS WILL COVER TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000) AND ENGINEERING ORGANIZATIONAL RELIEF FUND WILL COVER SIX HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$650) OF THE TOTAL COST LEAVING A BALANCE OF ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$1,190).

PARAGRAPH 7: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE HEREBY APPROPRIATES ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS (\$1,190) TO THE NATIONAL SOCIETY OF BLACK ENGINEERS TO DEFRAY THE COST OF ATTENDING THE 26TH ANNUAL CONVENTION.

PARAGRAPH 8: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2000.
