A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND FOUR CENTS (\$1,673.04) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS ABROAD TO DEFRAY THE COST OF A PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBIT OF THE WORK OF LSU STUDENTS WHO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN OVERSEAS STUDY.

PARAGRAPH 1: WHEREAS, THE DEPARTMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS ABROAD IS AN ESTABLISHED DEPARTMENT OF LOUISIANA STATE UNIVERSITY THAT SERVES HUNDREDS OF STUDENTS DURING EACH SEMESTER, AND

PARAGRAPH 2: WHEREAS, THE SUCCESS OF THE PROGRAMS DELIVERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS ABROAD RELIES PRIMARILY ON STUDENT PARTICIPATION AND FACULTY SUPPORT, AND

PARAGRAPH 3: WHEREAS, THE DEPARTMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS ABROAD SEEKS TO ELICIT BOTH STUDENT AND FACULTY INTEREST IN STUDY ABROAD THROUGH A PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBITION OF THE WORK OF LSU STUDENTS WHO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN OVERSEAS STUDY, AND

PARAGRAPH 4: WHEREAS, THE DEPARTMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS ABROAD RECEIVES NO PROGRAM FUNDING FROM THE UNIVERSITY OR SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM DEPARTMENTS WITHIN THE UNIVERSITY, AND

PARAGRAPH 5: WHEREAS, SUCH AN EXHIBITION WOULD ALLOW THE DEPARTMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS ABROAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO DISSEMINATE INFORMATION ABOUT STUDY ABROAD OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE TO LSU STUDENTS, ELICIT BOTH STUDENT AND FACULTY INTEREST IN THE STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMS, AND OFFER RETURNING STUDENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO SHARE THEIR OVERSEAS EXPERIENCE WITH THE GENERAL STUDENT POPULATION.

PARAGRAPH 6: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE DOES HEREBY APPROPRIATE ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND FOUR CENTS (\$1,673.04) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ACADEMIC PROGRAMS ABROAD TO DEFRAY THE COST OF A PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBITION OF THE WORK OF LSU STUDENTS WHO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN OVERSEAS STUDY.

PARAGRAPH 7: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT UPON PASSAGE BY A THREE-FOURTHS (3/4) VOTE OF THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE.

PARAGRAPH 8: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 2000.
