A BILL

TO APPROPRIATE ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1200.00) TO THE LSU A&M STUDENT CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF BLACK CHEMISTS AND CHEMICAL ENGINEERS (NOBCCHE) TO ASSIST IN THE PAYMENT OF THE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE.

- PARAGRAPH 1:** WHEREAS, THE LSU A&M STUDENT CHAPTER OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF BLACK CHEMISTS AND CHEMICAL ENGINEERS BECAME A RECOGNIZED STUDENT ORGANIZATION DURING THE FALL SEMESTER OF 1995, AND
- PARAGRAPH 2:** WHEREAS, THE COST OF ROUNDTRIP AIRFARE TO SAN DIEGO, CA, IS THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS (\$370.00) PER PERSON, AND
- PARAGRAPH 3:** WHEREAS, EACH MEMBER HAS APPLIED FOR A GRADUATE SCHOOL TRAVEL GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00), AND
- PARAGRAPH 4:** WHEREAS, DUE TO ITS FUNDS BEING EXHAUSTED, NO MEMBER SHALL RECEIVE ANY FUNDS FROM THE GRADUATE SCHOOL, AND
- PARAGRAPH 5:** WHEREAS, THE LSU NOBCCHE CHAPTER HAS COLLECTED DUES FROM ITS MEMBERS AND HAS CONDUCTED SEVERAL FUND-RAISING DRIVES, AND
- PARAGRAPH 6:** WHEREAS, THE LSU NOBCCHE CHAPTER HAS MADE ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE NATIONAL ORGANIZING COMMITTEE TO RECEIVE FREE HOUSING AND REGISTRATION IN EXCHANGE FOR VOLUNTEER SERVICES AT THE CONFERENCE, AND
- PARAGRAPH 7:** WHEREAS, THE MEMBERS OF LSU NOBCCHE WILL BENEFIT FROM PRESENTING THEIR CURRENT RESEARCH TO OTHER CHEMISTS AND INTERACTING WITH OTHER CHEMISTS AS WELL AS THE WINNER OF THE PAST YEAR'S NOBEL PRIZE IN PHYSICS, AND
- PARAGRAPH 8:** WHEREAS, THE ATTENDANCE AT THIS CONFERENCE WILL SOLIDIFY THE LSU NOBCCHE CHAPTER'S OPPORTUNITY TO WIN THE STUDENT CHAPTER OF THE YEAR AWARD WHICH WILL BRING ADDITIONAL PRESTIGE AND RECOGNITION TO THE LSU A&M CHEMISTRY AND CHEMICAL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS.

PARAGRAPH 9: THEREFORE, THE LSU A&M STUDENT SENATE APPROPRIATES ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1200.00) TO THE LSU A&M STUDENT CHAPTER OF NOBCCHE TO ASSIST IN THE PAYMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE.

PARAGRAPH 10: ALL MONIES NOT USED SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL CONTINGENCY. THIS BILL SHALL BECOME NULL AND VOID AS OF JUNE 30, 1999.
